



Scotia Garden Mackerel Toss Contest 2011

Rules and Regulations

The Seafest Lobster Festival & Parade of Lights would like to invite you to participate in the 3rd Annual Mackerel Toss Competition. This event will take place on the Yarmouth Waterfront at noon on July 19th, 2011. There must be 2 participants per team.

- Before the toss begins, both participants stand across the marked line.
- At the sound of the bell both participants quickly get dressed.
- Once dressed, one participant picks up the empty bucket hops in the big fish tub as the other participant picks up the bucket containing the mackerel and position's him or herself behind the marked line.
- Once both participants are positioned the mackerel tossing can begin.
- The "Catcher" in the fish tub can move his or her bucket in order to catch the fish, however any fish that touches the ground does not count.
- If a bucket is dropped during the toss the fish that touch the ground are out of play.
- When the "Tosser's" bucket is empty, the participants must switch positions and repeat the toss until all the fish have been tossed for a second time.
- When the last fish has been tossed the "Catcher" then runs across the finish line.

Each fish left in the bucket at the end of the toss will be worth 1 point. If a tie occurs the team with the fastest time will be the winner.

The winning team will receive a \$100 donation towards the charity of their choice and will be declared the 2011 3rd Annual Mackerel Toss Champion.

*Although fishing gear will be provided, the participants are advised to wear old clothes.
